

First Steps into Education

What will I get from this course?

This course has been specifically designed by an experienced tutor to support new learners develop the skills they need for further study.

This is a 12 week non-accredited course designed to equip adult learners with the skills, knowledge and preparation they need to progress to successfully completing a further education course.

Exercises will include:

- Complete a Core Skills Profile—identify areas which they would like to work on as part of the course (literacy, communication, numeracy...)
- Participate in Social Science Taster Sessions in Psychology, Politics, Sociology and Criminology
- Develop Planning, Writing and Research skills using the taught subjects as themes



Is this course for me?

The course is tailored to new learners where **no prior experience of further education is required**, as well as learners returning to adult education.

It is **specifically for individuals who have experienced barriers to accessing mainstream learning opportunities** as a result of experiencing homelessness, ex-offending, mental health or addiction issues.

What support will be provided?

- You will be enrolled as a Glasgow Kelvin College Student and receive a student card which allows you to access the college facilities.
- You will be supported in progression to other learning opportunities.
- You will receive travel expenses.



When and where will this course take place?

The course starts on **Thursday, December 6th 2018**, it runs for **12 weeks**. The class will take place in the afternoon, from **1.00pm—3.30pm**. (Date and time subject to change)
